October 19th - Federal Elections

Hello Everyone,

As we all know, the upcoming federal election is crucial to the future of Canada. The CLC has been coordinating a massive effort and campaign to bring down the conservative government and replace it with a progressive government. The FTQ is coordinating the campaign in Quebec where 9 ridings are being targeted.

We are now entering the final stretch of this long and drawn out election campaign. The CLC has highlighted a number of ridings out of some 89 specially targeted ridings outside of Quebec and is asking all affiliates to make an extra special effort in those highlighted ridings. What is needed, to use a bad quote, is "boots on the ground". Staffers and activists, officers, stewards and friends to call, to go door to door, to distribute leaflets, to help on election day and to talk, talk to the constituents. October 19th is coming fast and I know that recent polling and lame duck non issues like the infamous niqab have been causing jitters but it's not too late. What we see on the ground is not what the pollsters and journalists are telling us. Remember that the real ballot box question is: do you want to wake up, on October 20th, to another Harper Government? Some 70% of voters don't want to. Remember also that, 3 weeks before the 2011 election, the NDP was tracking at only between 11% and 15% in the polls.

In the attached list of all the targeted ridings, you will see those that are highlighted in yellow. I urge you to make an extra special effort to add extra

resources in people power – staff, activists, officers and stewards, especially in those ridings – to help push us over the top. If you don't yet have the contact information for the coordinator of those ridings, please, let me know.

I'd also like to remind everyone that advance polling is October 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th so that those who can lend a hand on October 19th are urged to vote in the advance polling.

There will be many events, rallies, publicities and so on coming up in the final stretch. Let's keep in touch and let's do everything we can to throw the bums out and bring in Our government.
